





Rainbow Pasta Salad

1 package (1lb) tricolor spiral pasta

2 medium carrots (shredded)

1 large onion (chopped)

1/2 tsp celery seed or 2 celery ribs chopped

1 med. Green pepper (chopped)

1 can (14 oz) sweetened condensed milk

1 cup vinegar

1 cup mayonnaise

34 cup sugar

1 tsp salt

½ to 1 tsp pepper



Cook pasta according to directions. Rinse in cold water and drain; place in a large bowl. Add carrots, onion, green peppers, and celery seed. In another bowl combine remaining ingredients. Pour over pasta mixture; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate 8 hours or overnight.


